

CONSENT TO DATA PROCESSING (pursuant to EU Regulation 2016/679). INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Pursuant to art. 13 of the European Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereafter GDPR or General Data Protection Regulation) and in relation to personal data that the International Association New Humanity NGO will obtain following your request to participate in the "Co-Governance: mutual responsibility in cities today ", we communicate to you the following:

Owner and manager of the treatment

1. Processing of personal data and its purpose

We summarize below all the operations we carry out that involve the collection, storage or processing of your personal data and the purposes we pursue with each of them:

- to allow the various activities related to the publication of texts and images;
- to guarantee the fulfillment of the various related bureaucratic-administrative formalities.

2. Legal basis of the processing

The above-mentioned treatment and reasons for treatment are rendered legitimate by the express consent of the interested party, with the exception of treatments imposed by law for which consent is not necessary.

3. Method of treatment

Your personal data may be processed both by paper and computer files (including portable devices) and in ways strictly necessary to meet the aforementioned purposes. All data processing operations are carried out in such a way as to guarantee their integrity and confidentiality.

4. Data retention period

In compliance with the provisions of art. 5 of the GDPR, the personal data collected will be stored in a form that allows identification of data subjects for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which the personal data are processed.

5. Who can your data be disclosed to?

5.1 - The data provided may be made available to employees operating within the International Association New Humanity NGO (referents, collaborators, employees, persons in charge of processing data in the context of their tasks).

5.2. - Your data could be communicated to subjects, bodies or authorities to whom the communication of data is mandatory by law.

5.3 - Your data may be sent to the subjects, who regularly collaborate with the activities of the International Association New Humanity NGO such as the Political Movement for Unity (Movimento Politico per l'Unità), the City Association for the Fraternity (Associazione Città per la Fraternità) and the New Humanity Movement (Movimento Umanità Nuova).

As the interested party, you have the possibility to exercise against the International Association New Humanity NGO all the rights recognized and guaranteed by the existing legislation, with regard to the processing activities concerning your personal data. In accordance with the provisions of the GDPR, you have the right:

- a) to obtain at any time the confirmation of the existence or otherwise of the processing of personal data concerning your person and, if so, to gain access to personal data as well as information on the categories of personal data processed, the recipients or categories of recipients to whom personal data are or will be communicated;
- b) to request the correction of inaccurate personal data, the integration of incomplete data or the limitation of their processing or to oppose their processing;
- c) to submit a claim to the Guarantor for the protection of personal data or to the competent Authority which is that of the place of habitual residence or domicile of the person disputing a violation of his/her rights, following the procedures and indications published on the Authority's official website on www.garanteprivacy.it;
- d) to request the immediate cancellation of personal data when the consent is revoked, or when the data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected or processed, or the legal basis for processing has ceased, or the data has been unlawfully processed;
- e) to "data portability": the GDPR introduces the new right to data portability. This right allows the data subject to receive his/her personal data in a format that is structured, commonly used and readable by automatic device, and - under certain conditions - to transmit them to another data controller without impediments. The data portability applies only to personal data that (a) concern the interested party, and (b) have been provided by the interested party; (c) whose processing is based exclusively on a contract or on the consent of the interested party; (d) data are processed only with the aid of electronic means (paper files and manual data processing are excluded from portability).
